



# How to: 6" Jointer

## Safety First!!!

USE: GETTING A SURFACE AND/OR EDGE STRAIGHT and FLAT

- Face surfacing
- Edge surfacing
- Rabbets
- Tapering

## Safety

1. Eye Protection
2. Check board for loose knots, nails, rocks etc.
3. Let machine gain full speed before putting wood to blades
4. Never remove guards
5. Be sure fence is locked in position
6. Do not run stock shorter than 12", thinner than 1/2" or narrower than 1/4"
7. Be sure hands and fingers are on top of the board and not over the end.
8. Use a push stick or push block when face jointing.
9. Do not adjust fence while machine is running.
10. Turn machine OFF when finished jointing.
11. Always keep machine free from clutter.

## Rules for using the jointer

1. DO NOT force on/off or adjustment controls.
2. DO NOT surface boards with paint, varnish or other finishes.
3. DO NOT use machine for glue removal.
4. DO NOT lay material to be jointed on the floor.
5. DO NOT attempt to adjust outfeed table.
6. Always stand to the left and rear of the machine while jointing.
7. ALWAYS turn on dust collection system while jointing and turn it off when finished.
