



How to: Router Table

Safety First!!!

USE: REMOVING MATERIAL FROM EDGES OF BOARDS

Safety Considerations:

1. Always use eye and ear protection
2. Check board for loose knots, nails, rocks etc.
3. Let router come to full speed before starting
4. Never remove guards
5. Ensure safe/secure hand placement
6. Check height/depth of cut with a scrap piece of material.
 - * If you are removing a significant amount of material, make multiple passes, raising the level of the cutting surface with each pass.
7. Feed material into the router bit from left to right
8. Keep piece flat against table top
9. Move piece in a continuous motion along the router bit
10. USE- feather board, push stick and/or tear out block

Rules and safety:

1. DO NOT force work pieces along the cutting surface.
2. Keep hands/fingers safe by utilizing a push stick and/or feather board to help move the piece along the cutting surface.
